

IPHC 2009 Year End Award Rules

2009 Idaho Paint Horse Club exhibitors must meet the following qualifications for year end awards.

1. Exhibitor must be a paid member of the Idaho Paint Horse Club. Membership must be paid in full by May 30, 2009.
2. Exhibitors must have a completed Year End Award Declaration Form submitted to Nola Krahn by May 30, 2009. (Form can be printed off www.idahopainthorseclub.com)
3. Awards are given on a per class basis. Each horse/rider combination will need to show in each class they wish to be qualified for under all 11 Judges:
 - 2 Judges -APHA Poor Boy Show May 31.
 - 8 Judges -Paint Idaho Supreme Classic August 14-16.
 - 1 Judge- IPHC Open Show May 30.
4. Exhibitors must complete the 8 hour work rule:
 - Work 8 hours at one/all IPHC approved show-IPHC Open Show May 30, APHA Poor Boy Show May 31, or Paint Idaho August 14-16.
 - Hours can be obtained during one show or may be spread out to more than one show.
 - A proxy may be used in place of an exhibitor. A proxy must be approved in advance by the Time Keeper or president before the work will be counted towards year end awards.
 - All hours must be scheduled and approved by the Time Keeper or president.
 - Time spent serving at meetings as an approved board member or committee member will meet the hours required, upon final board approval.

Point Breakdown for all classes:

1st-6 points, 2nd-5 points, 3rd-4 points, 4th-3 points, 5th-2 points, 6th-1 point.

*The number of horses in a class does not affect the point allocation.

*No Extra points will be awarded for any Grand and Reserve Halter Classes.
