

IPHC 2010 Year End Award Rules

2010 Idaho Paint Horse Club exhibitors must meet the following qualifications for year-end awards.

1. Exhibitor must be a paid member of the Idaho Paint Horse Club. Membership must be paid in full by May 16, 2010.
2. Exhibitors must have a completed Year End Award Declaration Form submitted to Nola Krahn by May 16, 2010. (Form can be printed off www.idahopainthorseclub.com)
3. Awards are given on a per class basis. Each horse/rider combination will need to show in each respective class they wish to be qualified for.
4. All IPHC Sponsored shows count towards year end awards:
 - IPHC Sponsored Open show-May 16
 - IPHC Sponsored Open Show-July 24
 - IPHC Sponsored 2 Judge APHA Show- July 25.
 - IPHC Sponsored 8 Judge APHA Show- August 13-16.
5. You must show in your respective class at the following shows to qualify for year end awards:
 - IPHC Sponsored 2 Judge APHA Show- July 25.
 - 1 IPHC Sponsored Open Show-May 16 OR July 24.
6. Exhibitors must complete the 4 hour work rule:
 - Work 4 hours at one/all of the following IPHC approved shows-IPHC Open Show May 16, July 24, or APHA Poor Boy Show July 25.
 - Hours can be obtained during one show or may be spread out to more than one show.
 - A proxy may be used in place of an exhibitor. A proxy must be approved in advance by the Time Keeper or president before the work will be counted towards year end awards.
 - All hours must be scheduled and approved by the Time Keeper or president.
 - Time spent serving at meetings as an approved board member or committee member will meet the hours required, upon final board approval.

Point Breakdown for all classes:

1st-6 points, 2nd-5 points, 3rd-4 points, 4th-3 points, 5th-2 points, 6th-1 point.

*The number of horses in a class does not affect the point allocation.

*No Extra points will be awarded for any Grand and Reserve Halter Classes.
